2. **Mark Goddard, Senior Supplier Quality Engineer at Schneider Electric, Keating Cross Road.**

Schneider Electric employs over 160,000 people worldwide and was founded in 1836 with headquarters in Grenoble France. It is the global specialist in energy management and automation.

Mark has a background in Electronics, Automotive, Aerospace and Medical Devices industries, both in the UK and in Canada. He has typically specialized in Supplier Quality Management, Continuous Improvement, Manufacturing Engineering and training on various related subjects. Mark also has a mechanical maintenance and machine shop management experience in plant machinery and turbocharger industries. The topic of his talk will be:

#### "Schneider Supplier Quality Management (SSQM): Overview of process to approve suppliers"

He will give an overview of the process from how Schneider globally approves its suppliers (Schneider Approval Module which is the audit process), how it approves them the manufacture specific components (Supplier Qualification Module which includes PPAP), and how suppliers are measured against their targets (Key performance indicators, or KPIs) and against their competitors (Supplier Performance Monitoring). All these processes are standardized globally, as well as the metrics that drive them.
